

SUBMISSION OF THE SCIENTIFIC PAPER

- Introduce your manuscript with a cover letter, addressed to the current editor, Check spelling, grammar, and punctuation.
- Include in the cover letter why you have selected this particular journal and suggest who might be interested in reading the article if it is published
- Always prepare your article according to the journal's Instructions for Authors.
- Check to see that all references are correct, including names, dates, and page numbers.
- Include only charts, tables, and graphs that display data more efficiently and clearly than you can explain in the text.
- Make captions clear and concise for quick understanding.
- Check every table against the text; validate points in figures; check every table again for accuracy. Number each table, graph, or chart.
- Remember that some articles get published but the majority do not. Have realistic expectations and learn all that you can from the experience.
