KEY POINTS

I. Using Microsoft PowerPoint

- A. To Start the Program Click
 - 1. Start
 - 2. Programs
 - 3. Microsoft PowerPoint
 - 4. Select blank presentation – OK
 - 5. Click on blank layout – OK
- B. To Change Background Color - Click
 - 1. Format
 - 2. Background
 - 3. Go down to arrow box
 - 4. Select color – may go to more colors
 - 5. Click on color – OK
 - 6. Click apply
 - 7. Alternatively, templates are available to format the background.
- C. To add Word Art
 - 1. Click on insert
 - 2. Go to Picture
 - 3. Go to WordArt
 - 4. Choose a design by clicking on one the boxes – OK
 - 5. Type in text where it says Your Texas HERE – OK
- D. To Insert Text
 - 1. Click on Insert
 - 2. Go to TextBox
 - 3. Click and drag curser to make box
 - 4. Type in box – may change font by right clicking in the textbox – choose font
- E. To Insert ClipArt
 - 1. Click on Insert
 - 2. Go to Picture
 - 3. Go to ClipArt
 - 4. Click on a category
 - 5. Click on a Picture

6. Click on top box with blue arrow to insert the picture
- F. To insert Image from the Internet
1. Click minimize on PowerPoint
 2. Connect to the Internet
 3. Search for a picture
 4. Right click on the picture
 5. Select Save Image As
 6. Choose My Documents
 7. Type in file name and the click Save
- G. To insert Picture in PowerPoint
1. Go to Insert
 2. Choose picture-from file
 3. Choose file to insert from desktop
 4. Click Insert
- H. To Add New Slides
1. Click on insert
 2. Go to new slide
 3. Choose blank layout – OK
- I. To View Presentation
1. Click on View
 2. Go to Slide Show
 3. Use arrows to move between pages

ACTIVITIES

- I. Read book from Medical Reading Book List.
- II. Develop a Medical Reading PowerPoint Presentation.

Teacher Note

Allow the students adequate time to read the book. On the due date for the rough draft, the students should come to class with notes in order to put the information on the PowerPoint slides. Allow adequate time in the computer lab for the students to organize their presentation slides.
